## 2010 NEW MEMBER APPLICATION

### FAMILY AND INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIPS

#### Dues

- If joining after July 1, 2010 subtract \$100 from this year's dues.
- If joining after August 1, 2010 subtract \$200 from this year's dues.
- Notice of annual dues will be mailed by February of each year; dues are payable by March 1 to avoid any late fees.

#### Membership Rejoining

- Work related absence from club:  
Zero to 18 months -- no initiation fee will be charged;  
18 months + 1 day to 24 months -- 25% of current initiation fee will be charged;  
24 months + 1 day to 36 months -- 50% of current initiation fee will be charged;  
36 months + 1 day or more -- 100% of current initiation fee will be charged.
- Absence other than work related from club:  
Zero to 24 months -- 50% of current initiation fee will be charged;  
24 months + 1 day or more -- 100% of current initiation fee will be charged.

#### Maintenance Assessment

- The \$50 maintenance assessment will be refunded if one family member attends one of the scheduled spring work days. A minimum of four hours is required per family.

### TENNIS PROMOTIONAL MEMBERSHIP

#### Eligibility & Rules

- The Tennis Promotional Membership is available to individuals who are not members of Mountainbrook Club. Current & former members of Mountainbrook Club are not eligible for this Promotional Membership. The Tennis Promotional Membership does not apply to families. Each individual who wants to participate in the Mountainbrook Club tennis programs must pay the fee and join as a separate member.
- Participants in the Tennis Promotional Membership will have full access to Mountainbrook Club tennis courts and may participate in tennis programming including lessons, clinics, free play, and Queen City tournament matches.
- Participants in this Promotional Membership must abide by the Mountainbrook Club Tennis Regulations.
- Participants in the Tennis Promotional Membership are not allowed to use the Mountainbrook Club swimming facilities unless as a guest of a Mountainbrook Club member. Mountainbrook Club will not be liable for property damage or injury occurring during unauthorized use of swimming facilities.
- Participants in the Tennis Promotional Membership are *not* voting members of Mountainbrook Club.

#### Dues and Full Membership

- Tennis only members joining after July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 may pay a reduced fee of \$100.
- Any participant in the 2010 Tennis Promotional Membership who joins Mountainbrook Club, Inc by July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 may have the \$175 applied towards 2010 initiation fees and dues.
- The Tennis Promotional Membership is active for 1 year from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 to February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011. After one year, participants in the Tennis Promotional Membership must join Mountainbrook Club, Inc. as either Family or Individual members and pay full membership and initiation fees in order to continue using the Mountainbrook tennis facilities.
- The Tennis Promotional Membership is not renewable. If the participant does not join the Mountainbrook Club, Inc after one year, he/she cannot continue to use Mountainbrook Club tennis facilities and cannot renew the promotional membership for another year.

### NOTICE FOR ALL MEMBERS

- Guest fee for Mecklenburg County residents to swim or play tennis are be \$3.00 per person on weekdays and \$5.00 per person on weekends and holidays, paid to the pool manager or lifeguard in charge. House guests of members may swim and play tennis free while with member. Non-member residents of Mountainbrook sub-division are not permitted to use the pool of the tennis courts.
- Non-adult, non-swimmers shall not be permitted to use the swimming pool unless accompanied by a responsible teenager or older person who shall keep constant watch on the non-swimmer. A "swimmer" is one aged 7 or over who has passed the Red Cross Advance Beginner's Swimming Test or who has demonstrated to the Pool Manager a swimming ability comparable to the advanced beginner.
- Diapers are not allowed in large pool at any time! Swim diapers purchased from Mountainbrook Snack Bar are allowed.
